Gabriel Sierra: Before Present Déjà-vu Artist talk

Gabriel Sierra will travel to Zurich to talk about his recent exhibition *Before Present* at Kunsthalle Zurich. Together with Daniel Baumann, he will then walk you through *The Playground Project*, the current exhibition exploring more than 100 years of play and urban space, art and architecture.
